CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

ANZCCART is now accepting abstracts from anyone interested in speaking at this years Conference.

Anyone wishing to present should prepare and submit an abstract of their presentation to **ANZCCART by 5pm (CST) Friday 19th June, 2009**. Please email the abstracts as an attachment to anzccart@adelaide.edu.au

Abstracts should be a maximum of one A4 page using Times New Roman 12pt font including any black & white figures if required. All abstracts must include the title, authors name(s) (with the name of the presenting author underlined) 12pt, with authors affiliations underneath in 10pt font. It is expected that presenters will also have a paper prepared for publication in the conference proceedings that should be submitted at the conference.

Short Presentations:

This year, we will also offering delegates the opportunity to present a short paper at the Conference. These presentations would be **approximately 10 minutes long**. Delegates interested in this session will need to email ANZCCART (see above) with a brief outline of what they wish to speak about and **have the option** of submitting an abstract and / or paper to be published in the Proceedings.

The theme of this years Conference will be ***“AEC - Best Practice”***, but papers and presentation covering other areas relevant to ANZCCART will also be welcome.

All abstracts received will be incorporated into a conference booklet given to delegates on arrival.

The Proceedings for the ANZCCART Conference 2009 will be published electronically on the ANZCCART website within months of the Conference.
