Accident Insurance Scheme

Your Union subscribes to an insurance scheme which covers University related activities and all members of the Union (and Sports Association). This covers both undergraduate and postgraduate students for campus related accidents.

All student members of the Union and members of the Sports Association are covered for medical costs (other than those covered by Medicare), physiotherapy and selected dental costs as a result of an accident incurred from direct participation in activities organised by those bodies, as well as those organised by the University. Where a member has an accident likely to result in a claim, a 'Notification of Accident' form must be lodged within 7 days of occurrence with the Sports Association office. There is an excess of \$100 per injury claimed. More information and claim forms from the Sports Association Office, level 5, Union House.

Travel Insurance For Postgraduate Students (does not cover Honours students)

The University carries Corporate Travel Insurance for any staff member or postgraduate student who is travelling on authorised University business (ie conferences, some types of research gathering trips and so on) within Australia or overseas. The cover is automatic providing your journey falls within the 180 day policy limit. For journeys beyond the 180 day limit an extension will need to be arranged via the Insurance Officer and additional premiums will be charged to the department concerned.

To be eligible for coverage under the Corporate Travel Policy you must fill out a leave of absence form available from the Student Centre or the Adelaide Graduate Centre, have it signed by your supervisor and school, and return it to the Adelaide Graduate Centre. You need to complete the section on travel details on the Study Leave form (or attach your travel itinerary to the form.)
