# Special lecture by Professor Ben Mol



Ben Mol is Professor of Clinical Evaluative Research in Obstetrics, Gynaecology and Fertility in the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Amsterdam (AMC-UvA).

Ben is focused on the organisation of multi-centric evaluative research in Obstetrics, Gynaecology and Fertility. He is currently involved in a national research consortium of over 50 hospitals, including eight academic centres; working together to carry out multi-centric randomised trials. The research is focused mainly upon everyday practices and includes analysis at the level of the individual participant (IPD analysis). In addition to his large-scale evaluative research, he conducts research designed to improve diagnostic processes.
