Professor John Morley is Dammert Professor and Director of Geriatrics at Saint Louis University and Director of the Geriatric Research, Education and Clinical Centre at the St. Louis Veteran Affairs Medical Centre.

Professor Morley specialises in research on Nutrition, Endocrinology, Ageing Successfully and Alzheimer's Disease. He has authored 21 books and more than 1000 research and educational articles in these areas.

Professor Morley has received many awards including Medical Director of the Year for Life Care Centres of America, the American Geriatrics Society's Nascher/Manning Award for his life-long achievements in clinical geriatrics, and the Marsha Goodwin-Beck Interdisciplinary Award for Excellence in Geriatric Leadership by the Department of Veteran Affairs National Leadership Board.

Professor Morley has served on the editorial board of nine journals. He was the Associate Editor of the Journal of American Geriatrics Society. He served as Editor for the Journal of Gerontology: Medical Sciences. He is the Editor for the Journal of the American Medical Director's Association. Professor Morley is the medical director of two nursing homes. He is a world renowned speaker who appears regularly on television and radio.
