Steve Ehrmann, internationally recognised in the field of online learning, is one of the founders of the Teaching, Learning and Technology Group in the USA. For over thirty years he has been working on three related issues:

1. how best to use technology to improve education --for what kinds of improvement can technologies be most helpful?
2. studying how to use evidence to guide and accelerate improvement in learning while reducing stress and cost (e.g., scholarship of teaching and learning; program evaluation)
3. faculty development and support strategies that can most efficiently spread those techniques.

Since 1993, Steve Ehrmann has directed the award-winning Flashlight Program on assessment and evaluation. Flashlight's tools, training, consulting and external evaluations help educators guide their own uses of technology, on- and off-campus.
