Give yourself a head start with paid work experience

Postgraduate Industry Placements offer a structured workplace experience for postgraduate students. Students are placed with an industry under a collaborative sponsored agreement for 12 months to undertake and complete a project as directed by the industry sponsor while continuing to study for an appropriate full time University of Adelaide Masters by coursework Degree.



What are the benefits?

- A 12 month industry-sponsored scholarship valued at approximately \$20,000.
- A contribution of up to \$9,000 towards a Masters by coursework Degree.
- Flexibility to undertake valuable paid work experience while studying.
- Certificate of Participation on completion of placement.
- Increased confidence, knowledge and preparation for the workforce.

What are the requirements?

- Enter into a collaborative sponsorship agreement with an industry sponsor and the University of Adelaide.
- Completion of the project within a 12 month period as directed by the industry sponsor.
- Comply with the industry sponsor's ethics, standards, and Occupational Health and Safety requirements.
- Participate in project reviews and mentoring activities.
- Document the project in report/thesis format.

How to Apply

The program is open to students who:

- hold a degree from any University or TAFE*; and
- are currently studying a University of Adelaide Masters by coursework Degree that requires a 12 month project as part of their coursework; or
- are intending to enrol in an appropriate Masters by coursework Degree.

** Applicants may come from any discipline and are not required to be graduates of the University of Adelaide. TAFE graduates are eligible to participate in the program where they are able to give satisfactory evidence of their ability to meet the requirements of the Masters by coursework Degree chosen.*
