Background

Yangtze River triangle area is one of the most prosperous economic regions in China. However, recently in this area, the energy in short supply and environment pollution have become two restrictive factors in economic steadily developing. As the promulgation of "Renewable Energy Act" in China, development and application of renewable energy become one of the most important ways to solve the two difficult problems doubtlessly.

This forum is the branch conference of "the third technical conference in Yangtze River triangle area", which will be held in Nanjing, Jiangsu, China in October 2006 and co-organized by Renewable Energy Association of Jiangsu, Energy Research Association of Jiangsu, Southeast University, Nanjing Municipal Economic Commission and Energy Research Associations of Shanghai, Zhejiang, Jiangxi and Fujian. The development, utilization, prospect of renewable energy and energy strategy and policy in wide Yangtze River triangle area will be discussed and communicated on this forum. The concerned renewable energies include solar, wind, biomass, ocean, nuclear, hydrogen energy, small water power station, fuel cell and so on. The researches about energy saving and improvement of energy utilization rate are also involved.

Conference Language

The official languages of the conference are Chinese and English.

Technical Program

The program will consist of an opening plenary session, several invited lectures and technical sessions. 140 or more technical papers in three or four parallel sessions are planned. Technical sessions will cover a broad area of subjects of renewable energy scale-up developing such as solar, wind, biomass, ocean, nuclear, hydrogen energy, small water power station, fuel cell and so on. The researches about energy saving and improvement of energy utilization rate are also

welcome.

Companions Program

Paper Submission

A 200-300 word abstract (In both Chinese and English. If help with translating into Chinese is needed, Please don't hesitate to tell us.) sent by email and post is required before submission of full-length manuscript. Four copies of the full length manuscript equivalent to four pages in ASME format with supporting figures and tables as appropriate must be submitted for the review by the paper committee. The work must be original and unpublished. The cover letter should contain (1) title of the paper, (2) name, address, phone and fax numbers, and e-mail address of authors and (3) key words (In both Chinese and English.) to categorize the work easily. All the accepted papers will be sent to authors along with the instructions. Conference proceedings will be distributed to the participants at the conference.

Conference Venue

Nanjing is a famous historic city described as "a birthplace of southern beauties and a habitat of royal rulers". As early as 6000 years ago, the earliest settlers began to build their village in Nanjing, and then made it as a wall city around the Spring and Autumn Period (770-476.B.C) and it served as the capital of eight dynasties in the period from the third century to the beginning of the 15-century A.D.. After 1911 the Provisional Government of Republic of China was established in Nanjing. Its topography and history have made the ancient cultural city full of tourist attractions. Now, Nanjing is a modern capital city of developed Jiangsu Province along the east coast of China. Transportation between Nanjing and major cities of China by air, railway, or highway is very convenient.

Southeast University is one of the national key universities administered directly by the Ministry of Education of China. The year of 2002 is the hundredth anniversary of Southeast University. Its main campus is located in the downtown of Nanjing. University Guest Hotel on the main campus, and different levels of modern hotel accommodations in the vicinity of the university are available and will be reserved for the conference attendants. Special discount rate will be available to ICRES D participants. Current rate of luxurious five-star hotel accommodations in Nanjing ranges from US\$ 50 to US\$ 120 per night.

Registration Fee
