#### ERGA CONFERENCE

#### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

##### Individual Papers

30 minutes (20 mins presentation, 10 mins discussion)

Submissions for an individual presentation may take the form of an abstract (500 words, not including references), or a full paper.

Full papers will be submitted to the ERA ranked journal *ergo* and follow their review process.

Abstracts, including those from full papers will be submitted to the ERGA conference reviewers.

##### Panel Sessions

60 minutes (40 mins presentation, 20 mins discussion)

Submissions for panel sessions may take the form of an abstract (750 words, not including references) or full paper.

##### Workshop Sessions

60–180 minutes

Submissions for workshops (to be held on 28 Sept) may take the form of an abstract (750 words, not including references) or full paper.

##### Review & Publication Processes

All submissions will undergo a double-blind peer review process. For reviewers' criteria, see the ERGA website.
