Abstract:

This talk will serve to generate discussion about traditional lecturing as a teaching method compared to more student-centred teaching models. Strengths and weaknesses of the two approaches will be discussed. In particular evidence for improved student learning in classes with student-centred teaching models will be presented.

Time will be available at the end of the presentation to discuss the data, and implementation of such teaching models in large classes.
