Los Angeles Airport Terminal Changes

Effective 1 October 2008, terminal changes will occur at Los Angeles airport for selected Qantas flights due to the introduction of the A380. The table below contains a summary of the changes;

What terminals does Qantas operate?

Qantas operates from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) via T3, T4 and Tom Bradley International Terminal (TBIT) including codeshare flights.

Are the Minimum Connecting Times (MCT) affected?

No, the current minimum connecting times remain unchanged.

Are Qantas codeshare services affected?

Qantas codeshare services are not affected.

- American Airlines (AA) codeshare services will continue to operate from T4
- Alaska Airlines (AS) codeshare services will continue to operate from T3
- Mexicana (MX) codeshare services operate from TBIT

Los Angeles Airport Terminal Changes

Departures ex Los Angeles

Tom Bradley International Terminal:

- All Qantas non-stop flights to Sydney, Melbourne (QF94) and New York (JFK) check in at the Qantas counters in the Tom Bradley International Terminal.
- Qantas codeshare flights to Fiji check in at the Air Pacific counters in the Tom Bradley International Terminal.
- Qantas codeshare flights to Tahiti check in at the Air Tahiti Nui counters in the Tom Bradley International Terminal.

Terminal 4:

- All Qantas flights to Brisbane and Auckland / Melbourne (QF26) check in at the Qantas counters in Terminal 4 at the far right-hand corner as you enter the terminal.

Arrivals into Los Angeles

Immigration and Customs Formalities for Qantas flights from:

- Sydney, Melbourne (QF93) and New York (JFK) are processed at the Tom Bradley International Terminal, arrivals level.
- Auckland, Brisbane and Melbourne (QF25) are processed at Terminal 4, arrivals level.

Inter-Terminal Transfers

Qantas passengers arriving at Los Angeles International Airport Terminal 4, who are travelling to Sydney, Melbourne (QF94) or New York (JFK), can now transfer easily and conveniently to the Tom Bradley International Terminal with the dedicated shuttle service departing from Gate 44.

The shuttle is complimentary for connecting passengers flying on Qantas that day and operates from 4pm to midnight daily.

Alternatively, passengers are able to exit and walk between the terminals and a free inter-terminal connection bus circles the airport on a regular basis to all terminals.

For connections to American Airlines proceed to Terminal 4, departures level.

For connections to Alaska or Horizon Airlines proceed to Terminal 3, departures level.

Lounges

Tom Bradley International Terminal Departures:

The First and Business Lounges are owned by Qantas Airways, British Airways and Cathay Pacific.

- The First Lounge is available to First class passengers travelling on a Qantas or **oneworld** carrier as well as Chairmans Lounge and Platinum Frequent Flyers travelling on a Qantas or **oneworld** carrier.
- The Business Lounge is available to Business class passengers travelling on a Qantas or **oneworld** carrier, Gold Frequent Flyers travelling on a Qantas or **oneworld** carrier and Qantas Club members travelling on Qantas, American Airlines or British Airways.

Terminal 4 Departures:

The Lounge is an American Airlines Admirals Club facility.

- The First Lounge is available to First class passengers travelling on a Qantas or **oneworld** carrier as well as Chairmans Lounge and Platinum Frequent Flyers travelling on a Qantas or **oneworld** carrier.
- The Business Lounge is available to Business class passengers travelling on a Qantas or **oneworld** carrier, Gold Frequent Flyers travelling on a Qantas or **oneworld** carrier and Qantas Club members travelling on Qantas, American Airlines or British Airways.
