Investments in Associates and Interests in Joint Ventures (excluding Cooperative Research Centres – CRCs)

Definitions:

An associate is any entity that the University has “significant influence” over. Significant influence is the power to participate in (but not control) the financial and operating policy decisions of an entity. The University is presumed to have significant influence over an entity if it holds between 20% and 50% of the voting power of that entity.

A joint venture is a contractual arrangement with one or more other parties (that are external to the University) to undertake an economic activity that is subject to joint control.
