The Australian Pain Society (**APS**) is a Multidisciplinary Society whose charter is to improve the education, research and development, diagnosis and treatment of all forms of pain. Australian Pain Relief Association (**APRA**) is a registered charity with the Australian Taxation Office and works closely with the APS to support education and research in pain.

The **Australian Pain Society** and the **Australian Pain Relief Association** have awarded ten 3-year PhD Scholarships over the last eleven years. Another Scholarship sponsored by Mundipharma Australia will be offered for 2012-2014. The stipend for this Scholarship is AU\$23,000 per annum and the **APS** will provide additional financial support enabling the candidate to attend the Society's Annual Scientific Meeting.

The award is to enable full time research leading to a Doctor of Philosophy or equivalent, at any recognised Australian University. The applicant must be an Australian citizen and the applicant and his/her supervisor must be members of the **APS**. The funded project can be related to any aspect of the mechanisms, diagnosis or treatment of acute or chronic pain.
