



2011-2012 Prospectus for Chinese Government Scholarship Programs at Lanzhou University

Lanzhou University(LZU) was founded in 1909. It is located in Lanzhou, the capital city of Gansu province at the upper stream of the Yellow River. LZU is a key university under the direct administration of the Ministry of Education (MOE). Today LZU offers 187 master programs and 56 doctoral programs

I. Disciplines and Majors

International students are welcome to study at any master or doctoral program that Lanzhou University can provide. For more details please refer to/ check the "List of Master and Doctoral Degree Program"

II. General Information on Chinese Government Scholarship

1. Scholarship students are exempt from registration fee, tuition fee, fees for laboratory experiment, f internship, and basic learning materials
2. Monthly living allowance is paid to the students from the date of registration at the following rates :

Master's Degree: RMB 1,700

Doctoral Degree: RMB 2,000

A one-off settlement subsidy after registration : RMB 1500

3. Students will be exempt from part of the fee for outpatient medical services generated in hospitals affiliated to Lanzhou University or appointed by Lanzhou University.
4. Lanzhou University will provide intramural accommodation for the individual scholarship student according to the relevant regulations. The university will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by any family members or visitors.

III. Details of studies

1. Full-time programs
2. All courses are taught in Chinese.
3. The duration of major studies is 3 years(not including language study). With specific cases, under the approval of the university and CSC, student can complete the program prior to or later than the duration.



IV. Qualifications for Scholarship Application

1. Applicants must be foreign nationals, and in good health. Applicants must hold valid passports and will observe all the laws of China as well as the rules and regulations of Lanzhou University.
2. Applicants for master degree studies must finish a bachelor 's degree or a degree with the same educational level and be under the age of 35.
3. Applicants for doctoral degree studies must finish a master 's degree or a degree with the same educational level and be under the age of 40.

V. Application Documents

Note :

1. *All forms should be printed double-sided with real signature at the bottom.*
2. *Applicants must send all the required documents by post to our mailing address (or express mail). Incomplete or invalid documents will be rejected.*
3. *The application materials will not be returned regardless of the result of application.*

Applicants must submit:

1. Two copies of International Students Application Form for Lanzhou University which can be downloaded from <http://sice.lzu.edu.cn/chinese/upload/51613478.doc> (with a passport-sized photo for each form) printed in Chinese or in English.
2. Two copies of Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship

Note : how to print CSC application form:

- . Log in to <http://laihua.csc.edu.cn>.
- . Register account.
- . Log in using your account and password, put organization code as 10730, fill in the application form and save.
- . Check details and print the form with your signature and photo.
3. Notarized version of applicant's highest diploma and degree (one original and one copy). Senior students should provide certificate which can show their expected date of graduation.
4. Notarized version of applicant's transcripts (one original and one copy).
5. A study or research plan in Chinese or in English (no less than 800 words).
6. Two letters of recommendation in Chinese or English by different professors or associate professors.
7. Two copies of Foreigner's Physical Examination Form (downloadable from <http://sice.lzu.edu.cn/chinese/upload/226143214.doc> or <http://www.csc.edu.cn/Lianhua/?cid=26>) and blood test report. Original form must be presented when registration. The medical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner's Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of



the attending physician, official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid.

8. Three photocopies of applicant's passport information page and 3 passport-sized photos.
9. Two copies of HSK certificate or notarized version, or other documents which can prove applicant's Chinese proficiency. Applicants who can not meet HSK requirements should study Chinese language first (scholarship will be provided).
10. Copy of any award received or documents which can show your personal talents or achievements.

VI. Applications Deadline

Applications should be sent before March 31, 2011. Prospective student should follow the registration date on the admission notice
