- 1) This application form must be returned to the Adelaide Graduate Centre **not later than 30 April 2010**.
- 2) **Eligible applicants from any discipline area can apply.** The title of the course does not reflect its relevance to discipline areas in Humanities and Social Sciences, Health Sciences or the Professions.
- 2) Before completing the form applicants should read the rules governing the scholarships and the selection criteria listed below.
- 3) As outlined in Section 3 applicants are invited to provide personal statements addressing the set questions. Please adhere to word limits at all times. We cannot guarantee that any documentation submitted over this limit will be considered.
- 4) Please note that it is your responsibility to ensure that your supervisor completes and returns the attached Supervisor Report Form to the Adelaide Graduate Centre **on or before 30 April 2010**.
- 5) The Graduate Centre should be notified of any subsequent changes in the information supplied. **This is particularly important in the case of change of address or contact details.**
- 6) You must provide **an original plus 3 copies** of your complete application.

- 8) Applicants are expected to maintain full-time enrolment in their research degree while undertaking the CTS.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Applicants must:

1. Be currently enrolled in a higher degree by research and have completed the Core Component of the Structured Program (CCSP). Failure to complete the CCSP renders a student ineligible to apply for CTS.
2. Be a domestic student, as defined in the Higher Education Support Act.
3. Not have previously completed any commercialisation training equivalent to the program offering.
4. Have at least 12 months of research candidature tenure remaining.
5. Be able to complete the Graduate Certificate within 24 months of commencement and within 6 months of completion of research candidature (whichever is sooner).
6. Have support from their principal supervisor.
7. Be accepted to enrol in the Graduate Certificate in Science & Technology Commercialisation.
