

Rules: Commercialisation Training Scheme (CTS) Scholarships

Graduate Certificate in Science & Technology Commercialisation

For current higher degree by research students in any discipline area at the University of Adelaide



Under a new scheme to support research commercialisation training the Commonwealth Government is providing funds for a number of full-time domestic Higher Degree by Research students to undertake the Graduate Certificate in Science & Technology Commercialisation. If funding permits there may be more than one round of offers in any year.

The Graduate Certificate in Science & Technology Commercialisation requires students to complete a total of 12 units made up of Core Courses (9 units), Elective (3 units) from courses offered by ECIC.

Students who have already completed a Graduate Certificate in Science & Technology Commercialisation (or equivalent award), are not eligible to apply.

- 1) Full time higher degree by research students from the University of Adelaide are eligible to apply providing they:
 - Are currently enrolled in a higher degree by research and have completed the Core Component of the Structured Program (CCSP). Failure to complete the CCSP renders a student ineligible to apply for CTS
 - Are domestic students, as defined in the Higher Education Support Act
 - Have at least 12 months of research candidature tenure remaining
 - Have not previously completed any commercialisation training equivalent to the program offering
- 2) Applicants must complete the Graduate Certificate within 24 months of commencement and within 6 months of completion of research candidature (whichever is sooner).
- 3) Applications must be supported by a referee report from the applicant's principal supervisor. This report is available from the Adelaide Graduate Centre website below.
- 4) **Separate application for entry to the course must be made through SATAC.** Further information can be found at http://www.adelaide.edu.au/programfinder/2009/gcstc_gcsc&tcom.html. Applicants must be accepted into the program in order to be eligible for the scholarship.
- 5) Applicants must maintain full-time enrolment in their research degree while undertaking the CTS.
- 6) **Commencement:**
Students are expected to commence the Graduate Certificate in Science & Technology Commercialisation in Semester 2, 2010.
- 7) **Value:**
 - Tuition fees up to the value of \$9,500 (this will cover the entire cost of the program), plus
 - Scholarship payments to the student of \$12,000 in total. This will be paid in instalments of \$3,000 on completion of each course within the program.
- 8) **Closing Date: 30 April 2010**
