TOPIC In this lecture, Professor Kennedy explores the ways in which power is exercised on the global stage and the resulting need to re-imagine law in light of this reality.

SPEAKER Professor Kennedy is President for International Affairs, University Professor of Law and David and Marianna Fisher University Professor of International Relations at Brown University. At Brown, he has responsibility for the university's international strategy, for oversight of the Watson Institute for International Studies, and for strengthening programs of education in research and in the field of legal studies. Kennedy is also the Manley O. Hudson Visiting Professor of Law and Director of the European Law Research Center at Harvard Law School, where he taught for more than twenty five years before moving to Brown, and Visiting Professor of Law at the School for Oriental and African Studies (SOAS) in London. He teaches international law, international economic policy, European law, legal theory, and law and development. He has practiced law with various international institutions, including the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees and the Commission of the European Union, and with the private firm of Cleary, Gottlieb, Steen and Hamilton in Brussels. His work with Cleary, Gottlieb, Steen and Hamilton combined European antitrust litigation, government relations advising and general corporate law. He is the author of various articles on international law and legal theory, and founder of the New Approaches to International Law project.
