Dr Parkinson graduated with a Bachelor of Economics in 1980 and a Bachelor of Economics (Hons) in 1981 from the University of Adelaide. He also holds a M.Ec from the Australian National University and a Ph.D from Princeton University.

In December 2007 Dr Parkinson was appointed Secretary of the Department of Climate Change. His appointment follows appointments as Deputy Secretary in Treasury with responsibility for domestic and international macroeconomic issues and as Deputy Secretary of the Climate Change Group in the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet with responsibility for leading and coordinating implementation of the emissions trading scheme and coordinating climate change policy.
