## HUMAN RIGHTS IN CHINA

The Confucius Institute at the University of Adelaide and the University of Adelaide Law School present a public lecture by Professor Xu Xianming, President of China's Shandong University.

A graduate of Jilin and Wuhan universities, Professor Xu Xianming is one of the most highly regarded and respected academics working in the area of human rights in China today. He was appointed President of Shandong University in November 2008.

Professor Xu has dedicated himself to far-ranging research in areas such as legal thought in modern and contemporary China, principles of the rule of law, frontier issues of legal philosophy, theories on human rights, and constitutionalism and legal sociology. He is the author of more than 10 scholarly books and has also published over 30 series or textbooks on legal studies as the editor-in-chief.
