

## Instructions for installing the Oracle Calendar Client for Mac OS 10

The Oracle Calendar client in disk image format may be downloaded from

Once downloaded double click on the cal\_mac\_OSX\_1011.dmg icon



When the disk image has opened on the desktop, drag the Oracle Calendar icon to your Applications folder located on your hard disk.



Once the icon has been copied to the Applications folder you can eject the disk image. Go to the Applications folder on your hard disk and double click the Oracle Calendar icon.



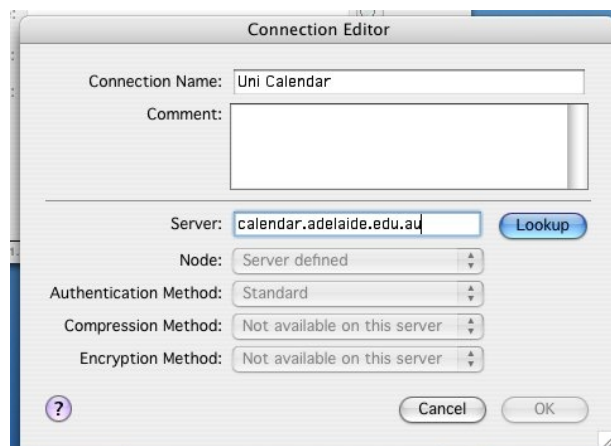
You will be presented with a Calendar login box. Please click on the "Other" box to take you to the Connection Manager to set up the connection to the calendar server.



Click "New"

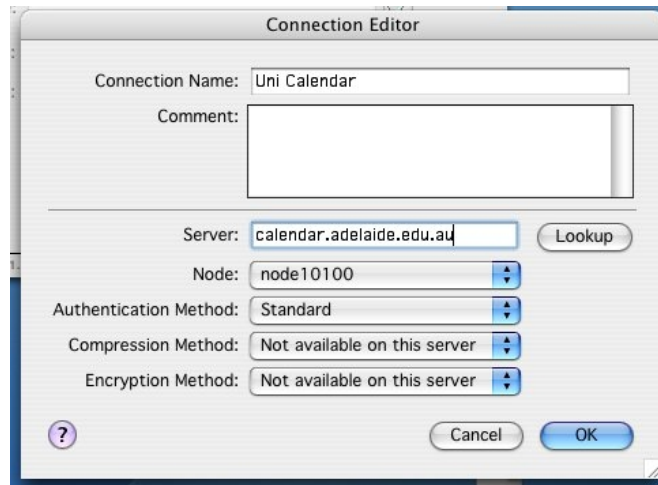


Type in a connection name – can be Uni Calendar.  
The server name to type in is calendar.adelaide.edu.au  
then click "Lookup".

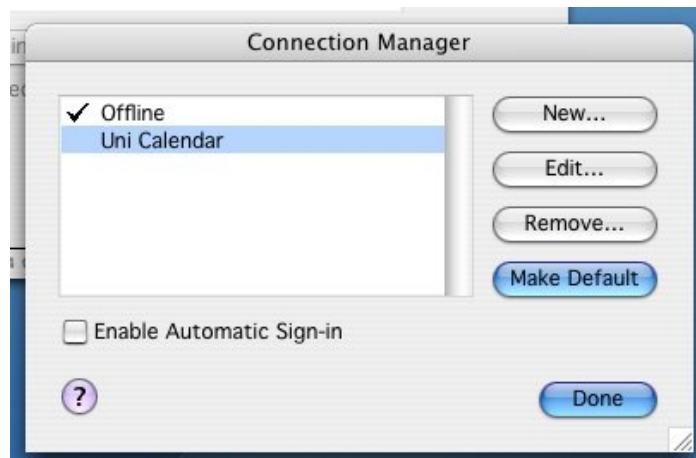

If you are online the connection manager should find the calendar server and automatically fill in the "Node" field with 10100. You may then click "OK"



select Uni Calendar and click "Make Default" and click "OK". This will default to the online calendar whenever you launch the Oracle Calendar client.



put your LDAP (email) username and password in the appropriate fields and click "Sign-in".
