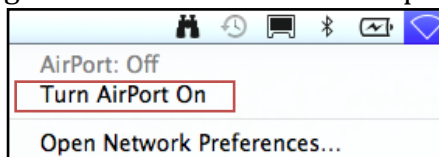



# eduroam Wireless Guide

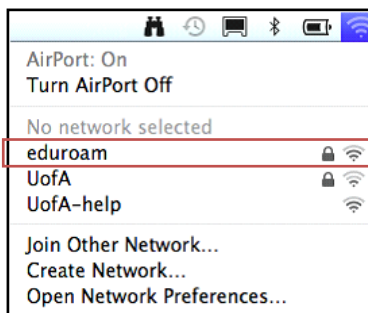
## Mac OSX

1. Ensure that "Airport" is turned on by clicking  in the toolbar at the top of the screen. Then select "Turn Airport On"

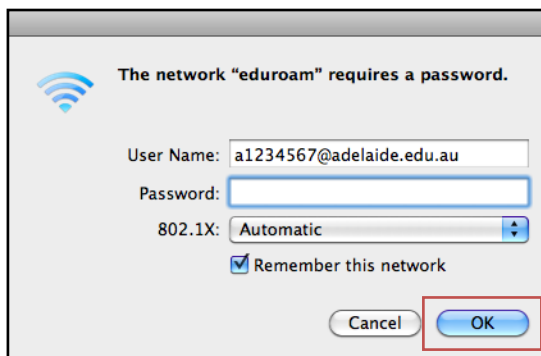


2. Click the wireless icon  in the toolbar at the top of the screen

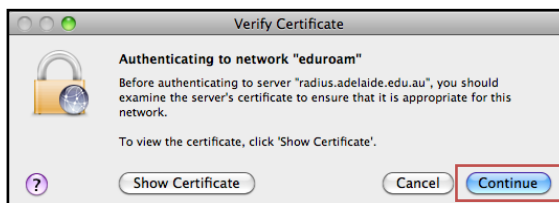
3. Select the eduroam wireless network from the list



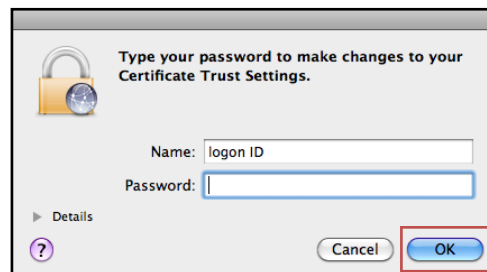
4. Enter your University username followed by @adelaide.edu.au (eg. a1234567@adelaide.edu.au) and password into the authentication window, then click "Ok"



5. Press 'Continue' in the 'Verify Certificate' window. \*\*



6. After pressing continue you may be required to enter the name and password for the Mac
