ESSENTIAL MINIMUM CRITERIA

- 1 Qualification in Veterinary Science acceptable for registration in South Australia.
- 2 Higher degree, preferably at doctorate level or equivalent, in veterinary diagnostic imaging, or a related discipline.
- 3 Evidence of significant contributions to the teaching effort of a veterinary school or faculty in veterinary diagnostic imaging.
- 4 Strong publication track record in peer reviewed international journals and evidence of the ability to attract research funding.
- 5 Strong interpersonal skills and demonstrated ability to work collaboratively as a member of teaching and research teams.
- 6 Experience with supervision of major honours or postgraduate research projects.

DESIRABLE CHARACTERISTICS

- 1 Experience in tertiary level curriculum development and administration.
- 2 Specialist qualification in diagnostic imaging (*highly desirable)
