1. Using examples, discuss the main influences upon Etruscan material culture.
2. Outline the major developments in the architecture of Roman Italy from the sixth century B.C. to the early second century A.D.
3. Using examples, describe how the styles of Campanian wall-paintings have been dated
4. How 'neo-classicising' was the art of the time of Hadrian? Use examples to support your view.
5. Compare and contrast the style and function of portraiture of the Late Republic with that of the Julio-Claudian dynasty.
6. Outline the major changes in public relief sculpture, from the time of Augustus to Hadrian.
