

SciVal: Signing in

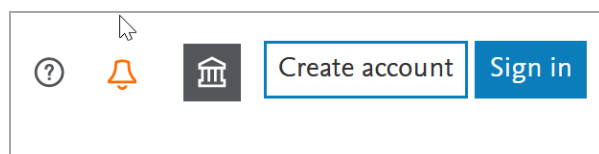
Introduction

Follow these steps to access the University of Adelaide institutional subscription to **SciVal**.

Procedure

First go to **Scopus** and **create an Elsevier personal account**. The username and password you create can then be used in all other Elsevier products, including SciVal.

1. Go to [Scopus](#) via the University Library website (and sign in with your University login details).
2. Click **Create account** (top right corner of your screen), and follow the directions to set up your free personal account:



3. After you have created your account, go to **SciVal** using one of the following methods:
 - a. [Access SciVal via this link](#).
 - b. Find SciVal via the **Databases by title & subject** link on the [University Library homepage](#).
 - c. Click on the SciVal link from the Scopus search screen (top right corner).
 - d. Search for SciVal using **Library Search** from the [University Library homepage](#).
4. In this instance you are already signed in to Scopus, which means that you will automatically be signed in to SciVal too.
5. However any other time you visit SciVal you will need to sign in to SciVal using your Elsevier account. From the **Welcome to SciVal page** click **Sign in** (top right corner of your screen).
6. Enter the email address and password that you used to create your **Elsevier personal account**.
7. Click **Sign in**.
