

Honours Prize In Physiology

Whereas a sum of money has been made available to recognise the achievement of the highest ranking Honours student in Physiology, the following are hereby made:

1. A prize to be known as the 'Honours Prize in Physiology' shall be available for award annually. Its value, unless otherwise determined by the Faculty of Science, shall be \$500.
2. The Prize shall be awarded by the Department of Physiology to the candidate who is placed highest in the first class of students enrolled in Honours Physiology.
3. These rules may be varied from time to time by the Faculty, but the title and general purpose of the prize shall not be changed.
4. If two or more candidates are of equal merit, the prize shall be shared equally.
5. If in any year the Department of Physiology does not consider that there is a candidate of sufficient merit, the prize will not be awarded.
