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The Acute Leukaemia Laboratory (Head: A/Prof Richard D'Andrea) has several projects studying at the molecular basis of Acute Myeloid Leukaemia (AML) and related haemopoietic disorders. Within this research group Dr Brown has a particular interest in examining the role of Transcription Factor (TF) dysregulation in contributing to AML pathogenesis. She has projects examining gene expression changes in AML as well as projects identifying the functional roles and target genes of known and novel transcription factors in AML. A new area of research is studying the post-translational regulation of TF activity by cytokine receptor signalling.
