

SCIENTIFIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Scientific Advisory Committee of the Freemasons Foundation Centre for Men's Health will provide advice to the Centre's Management Group, as necessary, on matters related to the strategic development and research program of the Centre including advice on:

- specific strategies and initiatives that enable the Centre to fulfil its mission and achieve its objectives (*refer to corporate brochure and/or website for details of mission and objectives*)
- the development of a comprehensive and multidisciplinary research program on men's health
- the development of strategic relationships with a range of key stakeholders including representatives of government, industry, academia, and the non-government sector
- strategies for health professional training, public education, resource development and information dissemination
- funding opportunities of relevance to the Centre.

Members are appointed for a two-year term with the option to renew. These terms of reference will also be reviewed every two years with the next review date being August 2009.

The Committee will meet at least once per year and more often as needed.
