11th April



In over thirty years of winemaking, Rosemount has established itself as one of Australia's leading wineries, producing wines that reflect the riches of the Australian terrain and climate. Rosemount, a diamond worth discovering.

24th April (Thursday)



Jane and Andrew Mitchell established the winery in 1975 on the Mitchell family property in the western hills of the Clare Valley. The grapes for the Mitchell wines come mostly from the company's three local vineyards, which sit at an altitude between 300 and 400 metres.

9th May



The Jesuits, (Society of Jesus) migrated to Australia from Austria in 1848 seeking a life free from religious and political persecution. They settled at Sevenhill in the beautiful Clare Valley and established Sevenhill Cellars, which is the oldest existing winery in the Clare Valley in 1851.

23rd May



Kilikanoon is a boutique winery with an international reputation for award-winning wines, located in the heart of South Australia's stunning Clare Valley. Since 1997, founder and winemaker Kevin Mitchell has produced wines of individuality with strong regional and varietal definition.

**HEWITSON**

Founded in 1998 Hewitson is dedicated to producing traditionally-made, expressive wines from the great vineyards that exist in the premium winemaking regions of SA. These regions are the Barossa Valley, Eden Valley, McLaren Vale, Adelaide Hills and stretch to the bottom of the Fleurieu Peninsula. Geographically these regions are collectively known as The Adelaide Super Zone. This is Hewitson's back yard..
