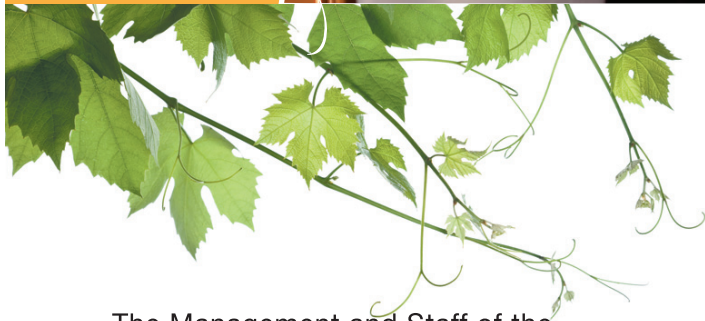


Fridays uncorked 2010
