Dr. Kate Fairweather-Schmidt will present her recent paper entitled: "Proximal mental health effects of concurrent infertility problems in a general population sample". Kate's talk is summarised in the following abstract: "The prevalence of infertility among couples is projected to increase as childbearing is further delayed and obesity rates increase. Relative to the female partner, little is known about the mental health status of the male partner among couples who currently experience infertility problems. The objective of this study is two-fold: to provide descriptive statistics for male and female groups with and without current infertility problems; and to elucidate the psychosocial factors associated with experiencing current infertility problems for each gender".
