Minor revisions	Changes to courses	Adding, deleting or modifying course(s) to an extent which does <u>not</u> change the nature of the program. (NOTE: this requires that adequate consultation be undertaken and reasonable prior notice given to any Faculties which include the course(s) in any of their programs.) Increase or decrease by less than 25% in core syllabus, majors or major sequences
