

## **The W V Scott Charitable Trust**

The W V Scott Charitable Trust was established in 1986 and is governed by a Will which states it is "...concerned with the promotion and encouragement of kindness towards animal or wildlife or the protection and preservation of animals or wildlife or the protection of endangered species of animals or wildlife as my Trustees may select..."

The trustees for the W V Scott Charitable Trust are Trust Company Ltd and two legal professionals based in Sydney.

To enable you to prepare your application please take into consideration the following points which are to be used as a guide only:

1. Consideration is given to the nature of the work and what the primary focus of the project is (i.e. is it new research or maintenance of existing programs)
2. Preference is given to both expertise and consumables (i.e. granting money for equipment needed for research or travel to undertake a project)
3. It is preferred that the allocated grant be spent in one year and so applicants are encouraged to submit a budget which can be broken down as such
4. Funds will only be provided to Australia organisations which are charitable and hold appropriate Australian Taxation Office endorsements. For projects overseas, applications must be made by Australian organisations accredited by the Australian Government AusAID program and the grant will be paid to this organisation

### **This is a new application process which is effective immediately.**

Applications will be assessed annually with the closing date 30<sup>th</sup> September.

All applications are to be sent directly to Manager Charitable Trusts, Trust Company Ltd. PO Box 361 Collins St West, Victoria 8007.

Trust Company will attempt to communicate a response to applicants in the January following the closing date.

Please note the decision of the Trustees is final and is not subject to any appeal process.
