American Fund for Suicide Prevention

AFSP offers five types of research grants:

- **Distinguished Investigator Grants [95]** for up to \$100,000 over two years are awarded to investigators at the level of associate professor or higher with an established record of research and publication on suicide.
- **Standard Research Grants [96]** for up to \$75,000 over two years are awarded to individual investigators at any level.
- **Young Investigator Grants [97]** for up to \$75,000 over two years are awarded to investigators at the level of assistant professor or lower. These grants provide an additional \$10,000 (\$5,000 per year) for an established suicide researcher who will mentor the Young Investigator.
- **Postdoctoral Research Fellowships [98]** for up to \$100,000 over two years are awarded to investigators who have received a Ph.D., M.D., or other doctoral degree within the preceding six years and have not had more than three years of fellowship support. Fellows receive a progressive stipend of \$42,000 in the first year and \$46,000 in the second, with an institutional allowance of \$6,000 per year.
- **Pilot Grants [99]** of up to \$30,000 over one or two years are awarded to investigators at any level. These grants provide seed money for new projects that have the potential to lead to subsequent larger investigations.
