The University will again be using a two stage process for ARC LIEF proposals, and invites Expressions of Interest from intending LIEF applicants. Expressions of Interest are required for any LIEF proposal involving any University of Adelaide researcher, regardless of the intended Administering Institution, and are due in Research Branch by Friday 4th April 2008.

Researchers should particularly note that they can not be named on more than two LIEF 2009 proposals.

The level of review provided by the Research Branch for Linkage Projects 2009 Round 1 full and complete proposals will be based on the 'three-tiered' internal deadline dates as follows:

1. *Comprehensive Review:* received in RB _by Monday 21 April 2008_
2. *Basic Error Check:* received in RB _from 22 April to 2 May 2008_
3. *Submit 'as is' - without review:* _received after 2 May_

We encourage applicants to consider the level of Research Branch review they wish to receive when planning the time required to complete their full proposal.

The ARC have summarised the main changes to the Linkage Projects Funding Rules at Section 5 of the rules. We will provide further notification when the Proposal Forms and other relevant documentation become available.

The Australian Academy of the Humanities and the Embassy of France in Australia are offering four fellowships for scholars who need to travel to France in 2009 to undertake research.

The Fellowships will provide a contribution to travelling costs of up to \$4,000 for short-term research trips of not less than two weeks. This grant is available to scholars resident in Australia and working in the field of the Humanities who require access to resources held in France.

Preference will be given to early career researchers; however, other researchers are eligible for the Fellowship and are welcome to apply.
