The University will again be using a two stage process for ARC LIEF proposals, and invites Expressions of Interest from intending LIEF applicants. Expressions of Interest are required for any LIEF proposal involving any University of Adelaide researcher, regardless of the intended Administering Institution, and are due in Research Branch by Friday 4th April 2008.

Researchers should particularly note that they can not be named on more than two LIEF 2009 proposals.

3. \*Submit 'as is' - without review:\* \_received after 2 May\_

### Thomson/ISI Web of Knowledge new ResearcherID database

A new ResearcherID database, is available that is intended by Thomson/ISI to be a community-driven approach to the development of globally-applicable, unique author identifiers.

ResearcherID provides authors with a means to acquire a unique personal identifier, allowing them to correct for all their own naming variations, and assemble a personal bibliography - drawn from papers by them as indexed in the Web of Science - on a public, open-access website. They can choose to advertise their own disciplinary interests, and can make their bibliography - complete with a graphical display of citations to their publications - publicly visible if they so choose.

'My ResearcherID' link appears at the top of every screen in the new Web of Knowledge interface <see <http://isiknowledge.com/wos>>. Researchers can register, login and have created for them what looks like being a portable, 'perpetual' unique ID.

This integration will, no doubt, lead to a rapid take-up of ResearcherID by authors of research papers. Indeed, if one searches at [www.researcherid.com](http://www.researcherid.com) one can already see University Adelaide authors starting to enter personal details. This trend is more obvious at ANU, Monash, UWA and UQ.

By registering with ResearcherID, authors can also use the integration with WoS to automatically create and update their bibliography. The obvious limitation here is the familiar one of WoS' own subject and journal coverage. Researchers can, however, upload any existing [RIS-formatted] bibliography into ResearcherID which should allow them to fill WoS bibliographic gaps [but not, presumably, citation gaps] for non-WoS indexed material.

At this stage, it is not clear if authors can export their bibliographic or metrics information. It is, however, all too easy to link from an institutional home-page to ResearcherID. See, for example, the US researcher Kay Dickersin's ResearcherID web site at

Applications are now open for the 2008 series of the Australian Institute for Nuclear Science and Engineering (AINSE) Research Fellowships. Applications close on 31 May 2008

AINSE Research Fellowships are tenable at any AINSE member university. Applicants are required to discuss, in the first instance, their research program with a chosen institution and provide an outline of the program agreed with the sponsoring university/institution. This year we have broadened the areas in which applications are encouraged, to include:

- neutron scattering;
- radiopharmaceuticals; and
- high-resolution climate records using nuclear techniques.

AINSE Research Fellowship are offered at academic level B for outstanding

and enthusiastic scientists with 3 - 8 years postdoctoral experience to undertake research in areas of science and technology requiring use of the OPAL reactor. Fellows will be expected to build a research group in one of the AINSE member universities and be attached to ANSTO for experiments on the new, state of the art facilities on OPAL. AINSE Research Fellows receive substantial allowances for research expenses, paid through their university, as well as the travel and subsistence costs associated with visits to ANSTO, conferences and Australian universities.

The fellowships are open nationally and internationally but the recipients must be qualified for entry to the ANSTO site.

AINSE is seeking to maximise the number of scholarships by offering each institution an opportunity to contribute to the scholarships. For the 2008 round the buy-in is \$50,000 pa.
