Proposals should address a particular Defence capability priority and are required to demonstrate their capability potential within three years. Applicants are encouraged to discuss their CTD proposals with the **Capability Development Group** of Defence, and with the relevant research division of the **Defence Science and Technology Organisation (DSTO)**. Proposals must originate from within Australian industry or involve substantial Australian industry participation. Project funding is expected to commence in July 2009, although some short-listed companies may be funded for detailed proposal development or specific activities at an earlier date (conditions apply). The level of review provided by the Research Branch for Linkage Projects 2009 Round 1 full and complete proposals will be based on the 'three-tiered' internal deadline dates as follows:

1. \*Comprehensive Review:\* received in RB \_by Monday 5 May 2008\_
2. \*Basic Error Check:\* received in RB \_from 22 April to 5 - 14 May 2008\_
3. \*Submit 'as is' - without review:\* \_received after 14 May

We encourage applicants to consider the level of Research Branch review they wish to receive when planning the time required to complete their full proposal.

The ARC have summarised the main changes to the Linkage Projects Funding Rules at Section 5 of the rules. We will provide further notification when the Proposal Forms and other relevant documentation become available.
