



- What to do if you are taken ill during an exam
- If you are ill during an exam, advise the supervisor who will guide you to the bed rest area.
- A statement that you reported ill during the exam will be noted on your exam paper and will be forwarded directly to your School or Faculty.
- If you are unable to continue with the exam, seek medical advice (as soon as physically possible and preferably on the day of your illness) from a doctor.
- Obtain a certificate of your condition from the medical practitioner. You will need a medical certificate to be considered for a Medical Supplementary exam.
- You will need to apply to your School or Faculty for Medical Supplementary assessment. The appropriate forms can be downloaded from the Examinations website.

- If you take ill during a supplementary exam, please see your School or Faculty immediately for advice.
