

The DPTI Civil Engineering Scholarship for Rural Students

This Scholarship has been established by the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI), a South Australian Government organisation that has diverse responsibilities in relation to transport system and services, energy policy and regulation, and infrastructure planning for South Australia.

The Scholarship provides an annual amount of \$3,000 for up to four years to assist commencing students who are undertaking a Bachelor of Engineering (Civil & structural) or a Bachelor of Engineering (Civil & Environmental) program of study at the University of Adelaide.

Continuation of the scholarship is dependent on satisfactory academic progress.

The scholarship is available to Australian citizens, or permanent residents undertaking study on a full time basis as a Commonwealth supported student. The recipient may undertake double degrees, as long as they remain enrolled in either of the above programs of study.

Students in receipt of other major Engineering Scholarships may not apply for this Scholarship.

Selection for this scholarship will be made according to academic merit and with reference to applicants' statements regarding their career goals, their potential contribution to a public sector organisation, their community and leadership activities and academic and other achievements. Academic merit will be determined according to ATAR scores.

Applicants must normally reside in rural South Australia.

The Scholarship must be taken up in the year in which it is offered; acceptance of the Scholarship offer cannot be deferred. If a student declines the Scholarship offer, the Scholarship will be offered to the next eligible student.
