SIR ROSS AND SIR KEITH SMITH FUND SCHOLARSHIPS 2012

These Scholarships have been established by the Australian Executor Trustees on behalf of the Sir Ross and Sir Keith Smith Fund - a fund that encourages scientific research, study and education in disciplines related to aeronautics and aerospace technology.

Two scholarships will be provided to support students in their fourth or final year (if undertaking a double degree) in the Bachelor of Aerospace Engineering program at the University of Adelaide. Each scholarship will provide \$3,500 for one year to assist with educational costs.

These Scholarships are available to Australian citizens or permanent residents undertaking study on a full time basis as a Commonwealth Supported student.

Selection of scholarship recipients will be made primarily on the basis of academic merit, which will be determined having regard to the student's academic performance in the third year of the program based on the students' Grade Point Average (GPA), or appropriate preceding year for double degree students. Students will be required to maintain satisfactory academic performance to continue to receive this scholarship.

The Scholarship must be taken up in the year in which it is offered; acceptance of the Scholarship offer cannot be deferred. If a student declines the Scholarship offer, the Scholarship will be offered to the next eligible student.

Applications for this scholarship close on 2 March 2012.
