

Important information – For International Students **Applying through SATAC**

Offer Rounds

1st round offers via email – 17th December

IB Students 1st round 6th January

2nd round offers 5th January

3rd and final round of offers 15th January

Closing dates via SATAC

Medicine Dentistry and Oral Health – Closed

All other Programs – 4th December for consideration in 1st Round of Offers

Last chance to change preferences – 13th January

Any queries relating to offers need to be directed to SATAC in the first instance up to the 13th January. After this date students will need to contact the International Office.

Other Information

English Language Requirements

As part of the application process students need to demonstrate that they have attempted an approved English subject. If they have attempted but failed their English subject then they will need to complete an English Language test and during their application through SATAC fill in their TRF number - this Test Report Form number will be found on their IELTS result form – bottom right hand side. If they do not have this to hand when they submit their initial application it cannot be added later on, instead the student will need to email it to SATAC via international@satac.edu.au Students should do this ASAP in order not to hold up the offer process.

Deferring

Unlike local students International Students applying through SATAC are not able to defer their offer for longer than 6 months. If they do not want to enter a program in the year immediately following their year 12 studies they will need to apply through the International Office at a later date. They should always bear in mind that if they do this they will not be eligible for Bonus points or Fairway Points. Offers received at the end of year 12 will allow them the opportunity to say if they would like to apply for entry at Mid Year of the coming year – always bearing in mind that not all programs are available for Mid Year entry – they will be informed whether their choice is available Mid Year or not in their offer.

Offers

Students and or their agents receive their offers via email only. Please ensure your students have provided an up to date contact email.

If a student is not eligible for an offer for any of their preferences -because they have not achieved the cut-offs / pre-requisites etc. they will not receive anything from SATAC.

Change of preference

If for some reason a student wishes to change their preferences after the final date for doing so via SATAC, i.e. 13th January, they are still able to do so but they will need to do it via the International Office via a web form – www.international.adelaide.edu.au/enquiries Students doing this will still be eligible for bonus points and fairway points as long as they are looking to start their chosen program in Semester 1.

Please note if a student has not applied through SATAC but applies direct through the International Office they will not be eligible for Bonus or Fairway Points even if they are commencing in Semester 1.
