

Load Pass Rate

The Load Pass Rate report shows the course pass rate using student load as the value. That is, the load for all courses passed (grade category not equal to FAIL and excluding 'special grades') as a percentage of all load for courses that were assessed (where a grade category is present, excluding 'special grades').

Load is used as a pass rate as it can be split over faculties at the course level to reflect the apparent pass rate for a teaching organisation.

Critical Success Factors:

This report can be used to identify the progress of the following University Critical Success Factors:

* **Student Progression – progression/success rate**

Default Fields:

Field	Description
Load Pass Rate	Value of course enrolment load passed as a proportion of that assessed.
Enrolment Year	Year of course enrolment
Teaching Faculty	The name of the faculty that teaches the course in the award
International/Domestic	Ability to select either international students, domestic students or all students (users can change this by selecting the required cohort via a drop down list)
Broad Program Level	A broad grouping of programs into categories such as undergraduates and postgraduates (users can change this by selecting from a drop down list)
