PAYMENT BY EFT

You can pay your tuition fees and other charges by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). This guide shows how to make a payment by EFT.

Electronic Funds Transfer

Payment can be made to The University of Adelaide via your normal bank transfer method (directly with your bank or via your own banking app or online service).

It is important to always populate the Account Number using your unique University of Adelaide 7 digit Student ID. If an incorrect account number is applied or multiple payments for different students are made using one account number, the funds may not be correctly allocated to the student account and could be returned unprocessed.

IMPORTANT: You are responsible for paying any fees charged by your bank. Please ensure that the amount which is being sent by your bank is equal to the total payment amount shown on your invoice. Payment must be in AUD currency.
