IMPORTANT DEADLINES AND GRADUATION CHECKLIST

If you anticipate you will complete your program in Semester 1 2020, or have already met the academic requirements of your program but have not been conferred, this checklist includes important information and dates relating to conferral of your award. Students conferred on 31 July 2020 are eligible to apply to receive their award at the following Presentation Events:

- September 2020 Graduation Ceremonies
- In Absentia September 2020
- April/May 2021 Graduation Ceremonies

To receive your testamur, you must select one of the above Presentation Events in [Access Adelaide](#). Testamurs are printed attached to the Presentation Event you select and will therefore be released at the relevant event time. If you do not select a Presentation Event, a testamur cannot be printed for you.

Friday, 5 June 2020	Engineering students only: Practical experience deadline <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline to submit your Practical Experience documentation to be considered for Semester 1 2020 conferral. 	
11:59pm Tuesday, 7 July 2020	Applications for Semester 1 2020 conferral of award close. This is the last day for you to apply for your award to be conferred on 31 July 2020. <u>Late applications cannot be accepted.</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check Access Adelaide and ensure you have an application for conferral. • View/Update the conferral application ensure you have selected a Presentation Event. Check your information carefully to ensure it is correct. 	
5:00pm Monday, 20 July 2020	Postgraduate Research Students Only: Thesis and AHEGS Abstract Deadline. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Last day to submit the final digital copy of your thesis to the Graduate Centre. • If you submit your thesis after this deadline you will not be considered for Semester 1 2020 conferral. 	
By 2:00pm Thursday, 23 July 2020	Graduation Status letters uploaded in Access Adelaide <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check that you have an 'Eligible to Graduate' letter <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Is your Major correct (if applicable)? If not, contact your Faculty. ○ Is your Honours class correct (if applicable)? If not, contact your Faculty. ○ Is your name correct (to be printed on your testamur)? If not, submit a Change of Personal Details form by 5.00pm Thursday, 30 July 2020. Names changed after this deadline will not be reflected on your testamur. • If you have an 'Ineligible to Graduate' letter, follow the instructions in the letter to resolve the issue preventing your conferral.

Before you complete your study	Check your finance summary in Access Adelaide (My Finances > My Account) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have a credit, please request a refund online here. If you have debt, ensure that you pay prior to the payment deadline below. 	
Monday, 27 July 2020	Last day to use BPAY, PostBillPay or ePayment to resolve any outstanding debts that are preventing your graduation.	
5:00pm Thursday, 30 July 2020	Anomalies Deadline: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You should have already checked the Graduation Status letter in Access Adelaide and followed up on any details that are incorrect. If you still have an 'Ineligible to Graduate' letter, the deadline to resolve issues preventing your conferral is strictly 5:00pm Thursday, 30 July. If your major was incorrect have you contacted your Faculty? If your Honours class was incorrect have you contacted your Faculty? If your name was incorrect have you submitted a Change of Personal Details form? A request for change of name submitted after the anomalies deadline of 5:00pm Thursday, 30 July 2020 will incur a fee of \$250 to reissue each testamur. 	
By 5:00pm Friday, 31 July 2020	Conferral Processed Conferral will be applied to transcripts, dated 31 July 2020. Ensure you have checked your transcript is accurate in Access Adelaide before placing any Online Shop orders.	
By 5:00pm Friday, 31 July 2020	Digital Official Academic Transcript and Australian Higher Education Graduation Statement (AHEGS) issued via My eEquals	

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING REPLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS AND ADDITIONAL ASSESSMENT, AND WINTER SCHOOL COURSES:

If you are offered a Replacement Examination or Additional Assessment, or if you are enrolled in Winter School, please be aware that the release of these results is after the anomalies deadline for Semester 1 conferral. If you are in this situation and wish to be considered for Semester 1 conferral, please speak with your Faculty as soon as possible. If your results are not received by the anomalies deadline, you will need to apply for the next conferral round, which will be Semester 2 2020.

Deadlines to select a Presentation Event

11:59pm Sunday, 2 August 2020	Last day to apply to attend an September 2020 Graduation Ceremony <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have you applied to attend a September 2020 Graduation Ceremony? If you wish to attend, login to Access Adelaide and select the Presentation Event prior to this deadline. If you are not applying to attend a Graduation Ceremony in September, the options to receive your testamur include: In Absentia September 2020, or the April/May 2021 ceremonies. <p>Regardless of your choice, you will need to select the corresponding presentation event in your Access Adelaide account by the relevant deadline. Graduates have 12 months from conferral date to attend a Graduation Ceremony.</p>
