

UNSATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS – GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

In accordance with the Unsatisfactory Academic Progress Policy, a GPA will be calculated each study period (semester or trimester) for each program that a student is enrolled in. The GPA is the average of the grades obtained in all courses, weighted by the unit value of each course. Students enrolled in more than one program, you will have a GPA for each, calculated using the final grades of the courses associated with each program.

GPA's will not apply to the Bachelor of Medicine Bachelor of Surgery, Bachelor of Dental Surgery, or Bachelor of Oral Health as all core courses in these programs are non-graded.

Students who obtain a GPA of 2.8 or less in a study period, will be contacted by the University.

Calculating your Term GPA

1. Your Term GPA is calculated by assigning the following points values to your final grades for each course:

Points	Final Grades
7	High Distinction, 1 st Class Honours
6	Distinction, 2 nd Class Honours A
5	Credit, 2 nd Class Honours B
4	Pass, Non Graded Pass, Unclassified Pass, Satisfactory, 3 rd Class Honours
3	Conceded Pass
1.5	Fail, Incomplete Fail, Unsatisfactory
0	Withdraw Fail, Not Awarded

Note that Withdraw Not Fail (WNF) and Continuing (CN) are not included in the GPA calculation.

2. Next the units for each grade are multiplied to give the total course grade points

For example:

Program	Course	Units	Grade	Grade Points	Units x Grade Points

3. Finally the total grade points are divided by the total unit values of the courses for each program

BARTS Program GPA

$\frac{18 + 20 + 21 + 16 + 4.5}{3 + 4 + 3 + 4 + 3}$	$= \frac{79.5}{17}$	$= 4.676$
---	---------------------	-----------

BCOM Program GPA

$\frac{15 + 0}{3 + 3}$	$= \frac{15}{6}$	$= 2.5$

The GPA to be used for the Unsatisfactory Academic Progress review will be calculated immediately after the mark submission deadline for supplementary examinations each semester.
