Process for applying for credit & funding for an ACICIS Study Indonesia program at the University of Adelaide



SO YOU'VE APPLIED THROUGH ACICIS, WHERE TO FROM HERE?

To be eligible for funding from the University of Adelaide and ACICIS, your overseas program **must count for credit towards** your degree (or be contributing to course requirements) for the Australian course of study in which you are enrolled.

It is up to your Faculty Advisor as to whether they will approve some credit for your participation in this program.

To apply for credit, you must:

- 1. Register your program in the GLAS Registration System via the Study Overseas website HERE.
- 2. Complete only the first half of the 02 Faculty Approval questionnaire (all questions marked 'STUDENT'), clicking 'Save' (not Submit) at the bottom.
- 3. Work through the remaining questionnaires in your application checklist, clicking 'Submit' at the bottom as you complete each one. There are some questionnaires that you may have to come back to later and submit.
- 4. Once you have received acceptance from ACICIS, you will need to upload a scanned copy to the 03 Host Acceptance Details questionnaire in your GLAS application.

FUNDING AVAILABLE

OS-HELP LOAN

OS-HELP is a government loan scheme where eligible students can borrow up to \$8,295 (Asian study in 2020) or \$6,913 (non-Asian countries in 2020) to undertake some of their course of study overseas. Your OS-HELP loan is added to your accumulated HECS debt.

Along with completing the questionnaires in your GLAS application, you will need to meet the eligibility requirements for the loan.

If you meet the eligibility criteria, you may apply for OS-HELP via an OS-HELP questionnaire in GLAS (available in the Post-Decision phase of your GLAS application). Payments will be made to students once they meet all eligibility requirements for the loan and their eCAF has been submitted. Payment is expected to take up to 2 weeks to be processed from the time an eCAF is correctly submitted. For further information please contact study.overseas@adelaide.edu.au.

NEW COLOMBO PLAN MOBILITY GRANT

ACICIS also offers <u>New Colombo Plan</u> mobility grants to eligible students participating in certain ACICIS programs.

Once you have been selected by ACICIS for a program, ACICIS will confirm with the University of Adelaide that you meet the eligibility requirements of the New Colombo Plan mobility grant. If you meet the eligibility requirements, ACICIS will inform you directly and will arrange for the mobility grant to be transferred directly to your bank account.

ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDING

To be eligible for funding, the following questionnaires in your GLAS registration will need to be completed and submitted:

- 02 Faculty Approval
- 03 Host Acceptance Details
- Confirm your bank details are up to date

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Comprehensive travel insurance is provided free of charge by the University of Adelaide for students receiving credit for this program. Conditions apply.

By registering through GLAS, you will be automatically covered by the University's comprehensive health and travel insurance. This insurance covers all of the program dates, and up to 50% of the length of your study program for personal travel outside of the program dates.
