



Quick Start Guide Importing Publications

Importing publication data


If you hold records in a reference management application (such as EndNote) or maintain a Google Scholar profile which contains your body of work, you can import these records into Aurora via **Import** in the **Publications** sub-menu.

The publication data should be in RIS or BibTeX format for uploading directly in to Aurora.

Aurora will compare the newly imported records with the current publications list (including any previously rejected publications) and will generate a list showing the new records and any matches.

If any of the publications match an existing record, you can accept the default option to "Supplement existing" or "Do not import". We do not recommend choosing "Import as new" as this will create duplicates. Select **Import** to complete the process.

The newly imported publications will now appear in your list under **My Publications**.
