# WRI RESEARCH SHOWCASE 2019 PHOTO COMPETITION

Want to share your research images with your colleagues and the world? Keen for a chance to win cold hard \$\$\$?

Then why not shoot some photographs of your research and enter our 2019 Research Showcase photo competition?

## What we're looking for

The aim is to produce an image to share your research with a general audience. Your photo can include scenes of you out in the field, at the lab bench – anywhere, as long as it conveys some aspect of your research. Be as creative as you like!

## Judging and prizes

The WRI Showcase Committee will select the best entries per category received by the due date for display on the day. These will then be voted on by attendees, and the first and second most popular choices will win prizes of \$500 and \$250 respectively.

## Judging criteria

Finalists will be selected on the clarity with which their photo and caption conveys their research and its outcomes or impact. Images can be in colour or black & white, but no special effects, manipulation or filters are allowed.

## How to enter

Image files must be submitted to Keryn Lapidge ([keryn.lapidge@adelaide.edu.au](mailto:keryn.lapidge@adelaide.edu.au) | ph: 8313 7073) by **5pm on Friday 1 November 2019**. Please also fill out your details on the form over the page and attach to the email.

If your image file is large, we recommend sending it using your [University Box account](#), [Dropbox](#), [Wetransfer](#), or an alternative file-sharing service. You may also provide entries on USB to Keryn in person.

All files must comply with the terms and conditions on the following page.

## Terms and conditions

1. You must be a UA staff member or HDR student to enter.
2. Entries must be made by one individual, and up to three per person may be submitted. A separate entry form must be completed for each image submitted.
3. Entries must be directly related to you or your group's research.
4. Entries must not contain any after effects, filters or editing with the exception of manipulation techniques used in microscopy.
5. Entries must have been photographed within the 2019 calendar year.
6. Entries must be received by **5pm on Friday 1 November 2019**. No late entries will be accepted.

7. Photos should be submitted in .jpg, .png or .tif format, with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi and size of 1000 px.
  8. Entries may be used by the Waite Research Institute for promotional/publicity purposes. This may include, and is not restricted to, on websites, social media, printed material, advertisements, press releases etc. and given to the media. Entrants may also be asked to be involved in additional promotional activities.
