ON CAMPUS PERMITS

After Hours Full Year

Rules and Regulations

This permit allows you to park on campus before 8:30am and after 4:30 pm Monday to Friday and all day Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays.

This permit entitles the holder to park in any plain white lined parking areas only.

This permit **IS NOT** valid in reserved, car pool parking areas, blue lined areas, disability access parking areas, 15 minute areas, yellow lined areas or loading bays at **ALL** times.

This permit IS NOT transferable except when two vehicles have been registered.

One Vehicle Registered

This permit must be affixed to the bottom right hand side of the windscreen (drivers side) so details of the permit are readily visible. However, if your vehicle is such that the permit cannot be placed there without obstructing the driver's vision, the permit may be affixed to the top centre of the windscreen, in the blind spot caused by the inside rear-vision mirror. There is a penalty if permits are not positioned in the correct places. Permits are self-adhesive and must be affixed to the vehicle registered.

Two Vehicles Registered

The permit must be affixed to a piece of Perspex or some form of clear plastic, in order for it to be used for both vehicles. Only one of the registered vehicles can be parked within the University grounds at any one time, and the Permit MUST be displayed. The permit must be placed on the dash at the bottom right hand side of the windscreen (driver's side) so details of the permit are readily visible.

It is not adequate to merely own a permit - the permit must be displayed when you park within the University at all times.

Failure to display this permit while working on The University of Adelaide grounds, or for parking in an area which is <u>NOT</u> valid, will incur an infringement notice.

Should a replacement permit be required for reasons such as window damage, theft, misplaced or vehicle sold, a replacement permit will be issued at a cost. Should any permit registered as damaged or stolen be found on any vehicle within the North Terrace campus, Police will be contacted and action will be taken.

Please Note:

- The possession of a permit does not guarantee a parking area will always be available.
- Those who use the parking facilities offered by The University of Adelaide do so at their own risk.
- The University of Adelaide reserves the right to adjust the fees for Car Parking at any time.

This Permit is issued by External Relations. Tenix Solutions Parking Services issue and receive payment for all Expiation Notices, acting on behalf of and at the direction of the University Council Delegate for Car Parking.
