Uploading a Recording to YouTube



The Account holder or candidate must create a Google account, then a YouTube channel, to which the Recording will be uploaded. The privacy setting should be set to unlisted so that the Recording can be shared with AMEB SA & NT but will not appear in YouTube search results.

The following guide applies to uploading on a PC or Mac through a standard web browser. Experienced users may be able to directly upload Recordings from a mobile device.

Creating a Google account

- 1. Go to https://www.youtube.com/
- 2. At the top right, click sign in
- 3. If you have a Google account, enter your details; if you are a new user click Create Account.

Create a personal YouTube channel

- 5. Insert your name and select **Create channel**. You can customise your profile or set this up later.

Upload Recording

Your Recording may be uploaded at the time of your choosing and then submitted to AMEB SA & NT.

- 6. Log in to your YouTube account and select the icon at the top right of the window
 - Create a Video > Upload Video.
- 7. You may be prompted to upload or 'drag and drop' the file at this stage. When a square window appears, ensure the privacy setting (Visibility) is set to **unlisted** before saving. (Do not select the public Public privacy setting as this might create a breach of Australian copyright law.)
- 8. The link for the unlisted uploaded recording will appear and can be copied at this stage. However, it can be accessed later if needed, via the below.

Submit the performance to AMEB

- When logged in, navigate to: https://studio.youtube.com/channel/
- Click on the video. You will be able to access the video's URL to copy and paste this in to AMEB SA & NT's online submission form.
