The anatomy workshop for Surgical / Radiology Trainees utilises interactive approach in tutorials, dissecting room practical sessions and museum tasks. The tutorials are interactive, using colour coded diagrams and images for which participants need a set of fine tip coloured pens. The dissecting room practical sessions offer a hands-on opportunity to study dissected cadavers for in-depth knowledge of bones, muscles, joints, nerves and blood vessels. The museum practical sessions offer structured tasks to consolidate knowledge assisted by video recordings for which participants need an iPad or laptop computer.

Workshop material: candidates will receive a comprehensive set of notes and a study guide.

A certificate of successful completion will be issued upon passing an exit examination and mandatory attendance of 80% of the sessions.

Skull, Face and Scalp, Cranial cavity, meninges, foramina and contents, Orit and contents, Ear, Nose and paranasal sinuses, Larynx and pharynx, Parotid region and other salivary glands, TMJ and muscles of mastication, Neck topography and fascial plane, prevertebral region, thyroid and parathyroid, carotid sheath, vessels and nerves, triangles and root of the neck. Cranial nerves central nuclei and peripheral distribution.
