

Honours scholarships are currently available. These scholarships are funded by Lallemand Australia for research in the areas of alcoholic and malolactic fermentation in the Wine Microbiology & Microbial Biotechnology Laboratory, University of Adelaide, Waite Campus.

These scholarships will provide a stipend of \$2000 for the successful applicant, along with appropriate project support.

The project areas eligible for support are:

1. Alcoholic (yeast) fermentation

The impact of yeast propagation on the genetic stability of selected yeast and the stability of phenotypes/properties expressed during alcoholic fermentation.

2. Malolactic fermentation topic

Directed evolution strategies applied to wine lactic acid bacteria (LAB) to produce superior strains. Evaluation of evolved LAB strains under high stress (SO₂, ethanol, low pH, etc) conditions.

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
